1. 到 dào - reach, arrive
2. 刮 guā - scrap, scratch (of surface), shave (essentially scrapping of skin surface to remove facial hair)
3. 别 bié - 告别 : bid farewell. A more common meaning of 别 is “other” or “another”, e.g. 别人. Another more commonly used meaning is “not to, don’t”, e.g. 别走 (don’t go).
However, these two meanings are too difficult to illustrate with a clipart. Do explain these two meanings separately.
4. 划 huá - row (a boat), the action of making a stroke.
5. 刷 shuā - brush
6. 刺 cì - a thorn or prick.
7. 利 lì - sharp
8. 刚 gāng - (1) The most commonly used meaning is that of “just”, e.g. 刚好 (which can mean “just in time” or “just the right fit” or “just at the right time”). (2) Another meaning of this character is “strength”, more used in the context of ‘strength of character’ or hardness, rather than physical strength. Both meanings are impossible to illustrate with a simple clipart. As this is a very commonly used character, so do introduce this character and explain the meaning even though it is not included in the minibook.
